HUNTER Programs International Homestay Application

Congratulations on deciding to become one of our host families. The host family is a critical element in any cultural exchange program. Your family will provide an opportunity for a foreign student to experience a new culture. Both the exchange student and the exchange student's real family are very carefully screened by HUNTER Programs in their native country before they are allowed to come to the United States. Throughout the entire hosting period, host families are in close contact with HUNTER Programs who will guide and assist them throughout their experience. The hosting experience begins with HUNTER Programs scheduling a convenient time to meet you and all members of your household. We will discuss your responsibilities and answer any questions you may have. Hosting an exchange student can be an extremely rewarding experience, but of course, there are responsibilities. Below is a list of responsibilities a family would want to consider in accepting the role of a host family. HUNTER Programs is included in the State of California Attorney General Registry of Student Exchange Visitor Placement Organizations.

Before the student arrives:

- Dedicate and clean a sleeping space, dresser and/or closet, bathroom drawer and pantry/refrigerator space for your student
- Make an appointment with HUNTER Programs for an interview and home inspection (*The inspection will include the student's bedroom, study area and all common areas of the home*)
- Know how to contact Emergency Services in case of an emergency

During the exchange:

- Provide a safe family environment for your international student to encourage the development of trust and friendship between you and the student
- Help the student feel like part of the family, with the same privileges and obligations as your own children
- English should be the primary language spoken at home
- Set and enforce house rules and curfew
- Set and enforce homework rules
- Provide household chores
- Provide high speed internet access, a private room with bed, sheets, towels, a dresser, and a desk
- Provide generic toiletries such as toilet paper, toothpaste, soap, shampoo and conditioner.
- Provide breakfast and dinner Monday through Friday and all meals on weekends and school holidays
- Provide transportation to and from school
- · In case of a medical emergency, know how to access and use the student's medical insurance provider
- Ensure the student knows how to contact family members, friends and other support networks
- Encourage involvement in community life by introducing the student to neighbors, friends and local groups
- Help the student understand local culture, and take an interest in the culture of the student's home country
- Students are not permitted to smoke

In order to ensure your exchange student receives a caring, supportive and warm family life, HUNTER Programs requires that you agree to host one student at any given time through our organization or through any other source. Once your application has been submitted, you will be contacted by HUNTER Programs to discuss your further steps for becoming a host family.

Generally host families plan to host students for one full academic year usually beginning late summer and ending in June. However, at times circumstances do change for host families or the student and it becomes necessary to end the homestay arrangement, or unlikely as it may be, compatibility issues can arise. Since we provide continuous support to the host families, if a compatibility issue were to arise, we would attempt to help resolve the matter before attempting to relocate the student. If either case, the host family will receive payment of hosting fees up through the day their student moves out.

HUNTER Programs agrees to pay _______ the sum of \$______ per month to host ______. HUNTER Programs mails monthly homestay payments on the 15th of each month for the upcoming month. Hunter Programs prorates* the first and last month of the academic year unless it is agreed that the student will stay another year, in which case the host is paid half fees for the full summer if the student leaves the host home for the full summer, with 30 day written notification to host family. This homestay agreement is for the ________ school year.



I also certify that I have not withheld any information that would affect this application unfavorably, if disclosed. I further certify that I understand that HUNTER Programs' intent is to deny a position to anyone convicted of a crime of violence or a crime against another person.

I hereby give my permission for HUNTER Programs to investigate, verify and obtain information given in this application, including searches of law enforcement and published records (including criminal background checks), contact with employers and interview references. I understand that this information will be used by HUNTER Programs to determine my eligibility for the international homestay exchange program. I also understand that as long as I remain a host family, the criminal history records check may be repeated at any time. I understand that I will have an opportunity to review the criminal history and that there is a procedure available for clarification, if I dispute the record as received.

I specifically acknowledge that HUNTER Programs or its affiliates will inquire about, and I authorize them to verify my employment, personal references and background, including criminal background checks which may contain arrest and conviction data. I waive any right to assert that such an investigation or request constitutes an invasion of my privacy. I recognize that such inquires are in the interest of all persons involved in the international homestay exchange program, and I fully consent to such investigations.

In consideration of my acceptance and participation in the international homestay exchange program, I, to the full extent permitted by law, hereby release and agree to save, hold harmless and indemnify, all members, officers, directors, and employees of HUNTER Programs, from any or all liability for any loss, property damage, personal injury or death, including any such indemnities, which may be suffered or claimed by me as a result of an investigation of my background in connection with this application.

I further agree to conform to the rules, regulations, and policies of HUNTER Programs' international homestay exchange program and its affiliates, and understand that my service can be modified or terminated. I understand and agree HUNTER Programs may, in their sole discretion, decline to accept my application with or without cause.
